1. DELETERIOUS





Meaning: causing harm or damage to living things Synonyms: injurious, inimical, hurtful, bad, adverse

Antonyms: beneficial, advantageous

2. CONTENTION



Meaning: heated disagreement or an act of competing for profit/prize


Synonyms: disagreement, dispute, disputation, argument, variance

Antonyms: agreement

Phrase: "in contention" — having (or not having) a good chance of

success in a contest

3. FACETIOUS



Meaning: cleverly amusing in tone, treating serious issues with

deliberately inappropriate humour

Synonyms: flippant, flip, glib, frivolous, tongue-in-cheek, whimsical,

joking, playful

Antonyms: serious

4. INDELIBLE



Meaning: making marks that cannot be removed or not able to be

forgotten.

Synonyms: inerasable, permanent, persisting, stubborn, unfading

Antonyms: erasable

5. DISCORDANT



Meaning: not in agreement or (of sounds) harsh and jarring because of

a lack of harmony

Synonym: contradictory, contrary, dissonant, harsh, jarring

Antonym: harmonious, compatible, dulcet

Phrase: strike a discordant note — appear strange and out of place.
