5 Words of the day

WE give you 5 words along with the visual way of remembering the words.

1. DESTITUTE (adjective)



Meaning: poor enough to need help from others Synonyms: penniless, impoverished, poverty-stricken, indigent

Antonyms: rich, wealthy

2. DEBRIS (noun)



Meaning: scattered pieces of rubbish or remains, loose natural

material consisting especially of broken pieces of rock.

Synonyms: detritus, refuse, rubbish, waste

Antonyms: valuable, treasure

3. PREDICAMENT (noun)



Meaning: a difficult, unpleasant, or embarrassing situation.

Synonyms: trouble, muddle, mare's nest, crisis, emergency, traffic

Antonyms: peace, blessing, boon

4. HOOLIGANISM(noun)



Meaning: Disruptive or unlawful behavior such as rioting, vandalism,

bullying

Synonyms: Rowdiness, disorganization, disruption

Antonyms: Continuation, peace, assistance, beginning

5. DENUNCIATION (noun)



Meaning: public condemnation of someone or something / informing

against someone.

Synonym: Indictment, accusation, censure, disapproval

Antonym: Being, concrete, reality

Phrase: strike a discordant note — appear strange and out of place.
